## Background

The Network of Instrument Technical personnel and User scientists of Bangladesh (NITUB), a voluntary non-profit, non-political learned society, is functioning since 1994 with the aim to improve the capability of scientists and technical personnel of Bangladesh to use, maintain and repair scientific equipment.

NITUB is regularly conducting training programmes on the use and maintenance of specific groups of instruments such as GC, HPLC, AAS, UV-VIS, IR and X-ray etc. So far, NITUB has conducted 76 training programmes. NITUB is also conducting Instrument Repair Programme through out the year through which non-functioning scientific instruments are being repaired.

However, the situation is different now due to the COVID-19 pandemic and therefore, real training programmes of NITUB could not be arranged since March 2020. The Executive Committee of NITUB in a meeting, decided to organize virtual workshops which will be mainly lectures on the use, application, maintenance and trouble-shooting on scientific equipment. The 1<sup>st</sup> such virtual workshop was on HPLC in the month of October 2020, 2<sup>nd</sup> was on GC in the month of November 2020, 3<sup>rd</sup> was on UV-VIS and IR Spectrometers in the month of December 2020 and the 4<sup>th</sup> was on AAS in the month of February 2021. The fifth virtual workshop will be on LC-MS to be held on 26 June 2021.

## Workshop

The LC-MS workshop will include three theoretical lectures on the use, maintenance and trouble-shooting of LC-MS.

## **Participants**

A maximum of 20 (Twenty) participants will be selected from among the applications of scientists and technical personnel of public and private educational institutes and research organizations. Regional and International applicants are also welcome to apply.
