Background

The Network of Instrument Technical personnel and User scientists of Bangladesh (NITUB), a voluntary non-profit, non-political learned society, is functioning since 1994 with the aim to improve the capability of scientists and technical personnel of Bangladesh to use, maintain and repair scientific equipment.

NITUB is regularly conducting training programmes on the use and maintenance of specific groups of instruments such as GC, HPLC, AAS, UV-VIS, IR and X-ray etc. So far, NITUB has conducted 76 training programmes. NITUB is also conducting Instrument Repair Programme throughout the year through which non-functioning scientific instruments are being repaired.

NITUB could not however organize it usual hand-on training programmes and other activities since March 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Executive Committee of NITUB in a meeting, decided to organize virtual workshops which will be mainly lectures on the use, application, maintenance and trouble-shooting on scientific equipment. The first virtual workshop of NITUB on GC was held on October 2020. So far, NITUB has organized 6 (six) virtual workshops on different instruments and the last one was on Specific Medical Instruments held on 22 August 2021. The 7th virtual workshop will be on "Basic Electronics" to be held on **02 October 2021**.

Workshop

The 7th virtual workshop on "Basic Electronics" will include two theoretical lectures on different aspects of electronics. University Professors will conduct this virtual workshop. A detailed programme is given in the circular.

Participants

A maximum of 30 (Thirty) participants will be selected from among the applications of young faculties, scientists, research students and technical personnel of public and private educational institutes, research organizations. Regional and International applicants are also welcome to apply.
